

2021 Spring Release: Three Bottle Selection Lexington Wines

2017 Lexington Merlot

Tasting Notes: 2017 Merlot from Gist Ranch Estate has a savory characteristic, expressing plum and black licorice with firm tannins.

Vineyard: The vineyard was densely planted in the year 2000 at elevations reaching 2300 feet above sea level, 17 miles inland from the Pacific Ocean. The heavily fractured, Vaqueros Sandstone soils and unique mountain micro-climate produce singular, deeply concentrated wines that demonstrate the power and elegance of the Santa Cruz Mountains appellation. The Gist Vineyard is farmed to organic principles with an emphasis on “Living Soils” and bio-diversity.

2018 Lexington ‘Alma’ Sauvignon Blanc / Sémillon

Tasting Notes: A Sauvignon Blanc/Sémillon blend, aromas of fresh peach, grapefruit, gooseberry, elderflowers and white currants. On the palate, it's medium to full-bodied, intense and concentrated, with a bright line of acidity and a long, penetrating finish.
